You can hand write or word-process the homework. Topic homework is in addition to the English and Maths homework that you receive weekly.

Make an A-Z list based on The Great Plague. Think about presenting your work in the best way possible. You could add illustrations or photos to each of the letters.

Write about the plague symptoms and the process leading up to possible death.

Research the plague doctors.



Why did they dress the way they did? Draw and label their outfit.

Write a diary entry as a child stuck in London during 1665. Make clear your feelings and the events taking place around you.

Write an acrostic poem about the plague.

Invent your own medicine as a remedy for the plague. You can write about this, make it using liquids or design a bottle with labels stating what it contains.
