



Year 3&4 - Spring Term 1- Mrs Thompson



Humanities

Our topic this half term is Scrumdiddlyumptious. We will enjoy a yummy journey of discovery - tasting fantastic fruits, venerable vegetables and tantalising treats. We will get busy in the kitchen and discover how good food helps us to grow fit and strong.

Art/DT

We will be designing packaging for the Willy Wonka's Lickable Wallpaper we will create. We will also be making a poster to promote our product. Later in the term, the children will be using shading and sketching techniques to sketch different fruit and vegetables.

Year 3/4 will also be making props for our upcoming performance, Ye Ha!

Literacy

The children will be looking at Charlie and the Chocolate Factory this half term. We will be writing an instruction text about how to make Willy Wonka's Lickable Wallpaper and we will be writing a diary entry about our time exploring the factory. Year 3/4 will be continuing to use and apply lots of grammatical features such as determiners, conjunctions, adverbs, prepositions and fronted adverbials. We will also be learning all our Year 3/4 statutory spellings through our phonics and SPAG lessons. Additionally, we will be practising our comprehension skills in our guided reading lessons.

ICT

We will be using copy and paste to create advertising banners to promote the Willy Wonka's Lickable Wallpaper we will be creating in class.



Science.

Our topic this half term is Nutrition. We will be looking at nutrients and what our body uses them for. We will do this by sorting food into different food groups such as proteins, carbohydrates and fruits and vegetables. Also, we will be planning and creating our own nutritional packed lunch. Later in the half term, the children will be looking at reversible and irreversible changes and how food can be altered.



Maths

This half term we will be looking at fractions. We will begin by counting up and down in tenths and hundredths and understand how they arise. Next, we will recognise, find and write simple fractions with small denominators. Year 3/4 will also round decimals with one and two decimal places to the nearest whole number, recognise families of common equivalent fractions, add and subtract fractions with the same denominator, recognise, find and write fractions of a length and of a shape and recognise, find and write fractions of whole numbers and sets of objects. Additionally, we will continue to focus on learning all our times tables and practise our reasoning and problem solving skills

Music

We will be continuing with our recorder lessons and we will be practising songs for our performance of Ye Ha.




PE
